

## Coverage for Diabetic Supplies – BCBS NC Medical and Prescription Drug Plans

Coverage is provided under both the durable medical equipment and prescription drug benefits of your plan.

This program is available to anyone covered by your plan, **but parents will need to log in to their children’s Blue Connect accounts to enroll them.**

### How to Enroll

1. Visit [BlueCrossNC.com/DiabetesWaiver](https://www.bluecrossnc.com/diabeteswaiver) and log in to your Blue Connect account.  
**If you’re a parent enrolling a child, you must log in to the child’s Blue Connect account.**
2. Answer the questions in the brief survey.
3. That’s it! You or your child are enrolled and don’t need to re-enroll. You’ll start saving immediately!

This program covers products purchased through in-network durable medical (DME) providers, not pharmacies. This means items such as test strips, needles, insulin pump supplies and more are included in the deductible waiver. (Continuous glucose monitors and supplies are not included in the deductible waiver.)

After signing up, the waiver is applied automatically in the claims process. You don’t need to do anything else when buying the supplies, so it’s an easy way to save time and money!

### Did you know you can participate in the BCBS NC/Teladoc Chronic Conditions Management Program through BCBS NC and receive a free glucose monitor with unlimited strips and lancets shipped directly to your home?

Simply contact BCBS NC Customer Service at the number on the back of your member ID card and ask to enroll in the program! You can easily order refill test strips and lancets using the meter. The meter uploads readings to a secure member account for easier tracking and reporting that can be shared with your provider. Additionally, personalized tips are sent out after each check to help improve blood sugar. Teladoc’s coaching team observes blood glucose levels over time and provides suggestions for reducing A1C and disease burden, as well as addresses any urgent concerns.
